## Mount Independence Historic Site Detour

The Mount Independence State Historic Site is open and welcoming visitors from 9:30 AM to 5:00 PM daily through October 15<sup>th</sup>.

Due to a road closure on VT Route 73 between Shoreham and Orwell, visitors traveling from the Fort Ticonderoga/Shoreham Ferry, should go east on VT Route 74 to VT Route 22A. Turn right (south) on VT Route 22A to intersection with VT Route 73 in Orwell. Turn right (west) on VT Route 73, and then straight ahead on Mount Independence Road. ## President Calvin Coolidge Historic Site Detour

The President Calvin Coolidge State Historic Site is open and welcoming visitors from 9:30 AM to 5:00 PM daily through October 22<sup>nd</sup>.

### Directions:

From points north, take U.S. Route 4 to the junction with VT Route 100A. Proceed south six miles on 100A to the entrance of the President Calvin Coolidge State Historic Site. The current work on Route 100A does not impede traffic approaching the Historic Site from the north.

From points south, please be advised that there is ongoing construction on Route 100A in Plymouth, Vermont, and the road is closed to through traffic south of the entry to the President Coolidge site from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday through Friday.

Visitors can follow Route 100N to Route 4E in West Bridgewater; continuing to Route 4E into Bridgewater Corners, visitors can take 100A up to the Historic Site (see the detour map below). The detour adds approximately 20 minutes of additional travel time to get to the Historic Site from the junction of Route 100 and 100A.
